Official Transcript mailed from previous college(s) attended OR
Official GED Transcript with scores from your acquired state ACT if under the age of 21
Submit signed photocopy of Social Security Card
CAREER STUDENTS
Application for Admission Official Transcript from your high school in a sealed envelope OR Official Official GED Transcript with scores from your acquired state Submit signed photocopy of Social Security Card
TRANSFER STUDENTS
Application for Admission Official Transcripts from previous institution(s) attended ACT if under the age of 21 Submit signed photocopy of Social Security Card

NOTE: Any student on suspension from previous college attended will have to go before an appeal to enroll at Coahoma Community College.
